General:

- Corrected the name of one photographer.

Version 1.1 (Released 2020-11-19)

General:

- Updated the name of one photographer.
- Added some explanatory text to the images of *Appias* and *Mylothris* to better highlight the difference in the shape of their dark marginal spots.

Page 8: (*Eurema* ID key)

- Adjusted text justification to avoid problems with the scroll-bar blocking text on the right-hand side on some systems.
- Clarified and corrected some text.

Page 13: (*Nepheronia argia*)

- Re-arranged the images to place the male photos to the left and female photos to the right.
- Replaced the male ventral image.

Page 22: (*Colotis protomedia*)

- Replaced the dorsal female image.

Page 34: (*Belenois aurota*)

- Replaced the ventral image and the female image.
